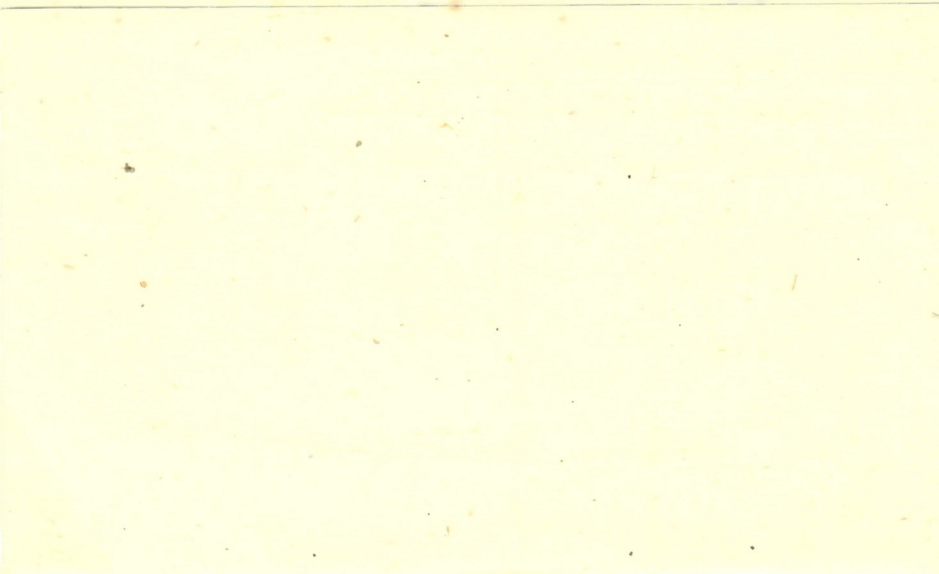

body. Space & time hoodwink you so that you are not aware of your own hood.

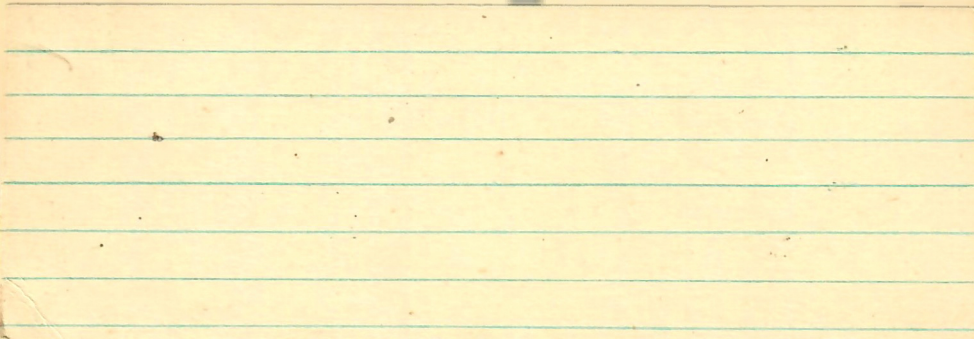
