Number of Monads.

Your knowledge is at the level of the Object Known. This is very evident when you come to Higher Monads. Only a Universe can see a universe. When you see a spiral universe, you are seen from that universe as a universe. When you see a man, you are seen from him, as a man. This is evidence that you are at the level of what you are dealing with. You are all the levels, all the time, but your attention wanders from one to another. Another piece of wisdom : God is invisible, as God, from any lower level - which is inside God. The above is the explanation of the fact that a monad appears to be aware of other levels of monads than his own : as at a given level, you only know at that level.

Strüder: "Health" p. 156 "Sudden fear either excites or calms; & there is some evidence that in the tiger's grip (even with a human being) fear (157) inhibits feeling & produces anaesthesia in the prey."
Guru: This is sinking to animal level in your dealings with it. Also soldiers & football players sometimes do not notice minor injury & certainly don't feel pain. They are functioning at a 'savage' level.

Strüder: "Health", (p 289): It is only from within that we can know God. (290) A human friend I know by sight & touch, but not this do I know the Infinite. Infinite life can't be intellectually understood, but appreciated by life of a similar quality, working Himself to this within whom life similar in quality to His own has begun to be generated. (Our God can be known only from within). S.e only from without. God: no outside, ^{SE} no inside.

(This) Teaching - conditioning of reflexes - goes on continually at sub-levels of body. Cells?, tissues, & organs learn





(As in films & as often in real life.) All things are seen in a mirror. That is to say the object is either oneself or an extension of oneself.




Alice sees herself in the mirror. Alice sees the object out there as apart from herself as Other. This is essential. But it is also essential that the presence of the mirror between oneself & the object, should be natural; & the fact that this mirror makes what you see an extension of yourself. The objects you see "in the looking glass" are given as not-you, but as natural to be yourself, as when one recognises oneself in the mirror.

"Holding up the mirror to nature." The fact that one can only see ones own face in the mirror & nothing else should warn us or prepare us for the notion that the same is true of all the rest


of the body, in actual fact.



The mirror




Alice not only eats the Toadstool, but walks
into the Looking Glass!


Notes:-

- ① The center is drawn in the construct -ive always, by ~~X~~.
- ② All objects you see in the mirror are inversions of the Δ of the Body. The eye must be drawn.
- ③ Note that the objects on either side of the mirror are truly around and wise.

Between your eye & the mirror is your body! Your body is turned inside out, so that your eye looks through your body at the mirror!



④ Object & reflection diminish as they recede from mirror, giving our double pyramid.
