forgive. (Our Christ took on the world's guilt by plenaria)
153: We must work "not merely for ourselves, not merely that
we may individually enter in the timeless life," but "if
works is to last," for civilization who has past its youth

"The ethic which does not depend on a Cosmology is untrue; the Cosmology which does not result in an Ethic, a life of deductive action, is meaningless." Our ethic has depended on an anthropomorphic cosmology & has failed because people can't believe the cosmology, while the cosmology we do accept has been mechanistic & so results in utterly unethical behaviour.



so when we can trace connection of clothes & building
change occurs first in building & so passes to
clothes. Evidence of projection. At these transitional
levels change can be effected only by environment
being altered, & then that alteration reflecting
back upon & so modifying structure. (One the
process goes further inwards when clothes modify
body - e.g. corsets)

In building, however much he was working out
a convention, man would be more direct, self-

conscious, & inventive about it, because it would be further from him & he could therefore focus on it more clearly. Then the idea wrought in the immediate environment would reflect back upon the inner cortex, which, being more structural than environmental, must change more slowly & indirectly.

(Our Evolution of Self-consciousness: we don't yet aware really of our bodies in their wholes. Self-consciousness working in from the field of our basic consciousness: from the PRESENT, the field of practical activity, to our PAST - the body ... to cells & so on.
